Entry Fee	Entry fee is 50c per bird. All birds entered must be paid for. Birds entered in BRASEA section are free. (classes 41 – 60)	
Postage	The Society requests all exhibitors advise if return of stickers is required. If so \$1.50 will be added to the entry fee for priority posting.	
Cages	All exhibits to be staged in recognised show cages. At the discretion of the Show Committee any bird in a dirty or badly presented cage may be disqualified from being judged.	
Class Labels	To be affixed to right hand side bottom corner of cage.

Ring numbers	If a parent society has issued P.R.B.S. Inc. with a current ring list, ring numbers need not be declared on entry form. It is the responsibility of exhibitors to ensure that a ring list has been supplied. Spot ring checks may be made.	
Young birds	Must be rung with a 2018 (red) closed ring and must be owned and bred by the exhibitor. Split rings are not permitted.	
Old Birds	Unisex – use cock numbers on schedule	
BRASEA Section	Open, Intermediate and Novice are all entered together. No entry fee charged for birds in this section.	
Staging	All birds to be staged between 7.30 a.m. and 8.30 a.m.	
Judging	To commence at 9.00 a.m. and will be to the Australian standard.	
Lunch	Will be available at a nominal cost	
Presentation	1.30. p.m. approximately	
Selling birds	Birds for this section may be entered on the morning of the show. A maximum of 4 birds of different colours per cage. A commission of 10% of the selling price will be charged. Please affix class label to cage stating your name and the variety, sex and price of birds entered.

- * When placing entries please ensure you state whether Any Age, Old, Young, Nestfeather or Juvenile birds are being entered.
- * Green Series includes Light, Dark, Olive and Grey Green.
- * Blue Series includes Skyblue, Cobalt, Mauve, Violet and Grey.
- * All classes are in accordance with the ANBC Standard and Matrix - Amendment 1 of 2012
- * Multiple factor birds exist in many combinations. Therefore , if the schedule does not list a certain colour/variety combination then these birds will go into the AOV and Non Standardised classes. Refer ANBC Standard colour matrix for combinations.
- * Any bird carrying multiple factors will only be eligible for awards which can be directly taken by the particular class in which they are entered.
- * If you have a bird carrying multiple variety factors, please refer to the colour matrix from the ANBC Standard to see what class you can enter your bird in. For example, if you have a bird that is visually a Dominant Pied, Opaline, Cinnamon, Yellowface and Grey you would check to see the highest section number in the matrix and if all the other factors are included, then that is the class to enter the bird in. In the instance of the bird described, Dominant Pied (sect 16) is the highest, included is Opaline (sect 11), cinnamon (sect 9) Yellowface (sect 3) and grey (sect 2), so therefore in this instance you would enter this particular bird as a Dominant Pied either class 33 or 34 dependant whether a cock or hen.
- * Variable class to be nominated on the Show Schedule by each club as required.
